Dance List and Dress Style:

Formal Dances

- Junior Prom

Ladies- Nice Gown, Dress, Skirt
Gentlemen- Suits, Tuxedos, Collared Shirt, Tie, Sport Coat
No denim pants or t-shirts

Semiformal

- Homecoming
- WA
- Sweethearts

Ladies- Dress, Skirt or Dress Pants
Gentlemen- Long dress pants, collared shirt, no denim pants or t-shirts

Casual

- Morp
- Theme
- All Stomps

Ladies and Gentlemen - Dress according to dance theme and Canyons District School Dress Code Policy and BHS Dance Guidelines

General Guidelines

For Gentlemen

- Shirts must have sleeves
- No undergarments may be visible
- Must be well groomed

For Ladies

- All dresses must have two straps. (*Hanger straps do not count*)
- No halter tops
- Back of dress must sit at your natural waist.
- No plunging neck line, short hem length, or excessive slits in dresses
- Dress length must be no shorter

For Everyone

- One member of a dance couple must be a registered Brighton student
- Clothing and shoes must be worn at all times (bring comfortable shoes)
- No hats, canes, bandanas, masks, sunglasses or gang attire
- No revealing, see through or any inappropriate clothing
- No grubby, cut or demolished clothing unless specified by a theme
- No facsimiles of weapons

Notice: If your clothing is questionable or you do not meet these guidelines you could be asked to change or leave with no reentry.
