11th GRADE STUDENTS MUST BRING FOUR (4) ITEMS:

- <u>Photo Identification Required</u> ACCEPTABLE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION must be presented at the
 time of check-in or you will not be admitted to the test. The ID you present must be original, not a
 photocopy or reproduction. <u>Student must bring current (valid) Official Photo ID</u>: Must be issued by
 your school or city/state/federal government (such as school ID card, driver's license or passport) on
 which BOTH your name and current photograph appear.
- #2 Pencils (NO MECHANICAL PENCILS) BRING YOUR OWN PENCILS
 Use sharpened soft lead No. 2 pencils with good erasers (no mechanical pencils or ink pens), because your answer document will be processed by machine. Be sure to bring several No. 2 pencils WITH GOOD ERASERS.
- 3. <u>Calculator</u> (calculators are not provided... they are optional)

You may use a calculator on the ACT Mathematics Test only, but not on any other sections of the ACT Test. You are NOT required to use a calculator. All problems on the Mathematics Test can be solved without a calculator. Check handout included in this envelope or act.org/calculator on the internet

Note: You may use any four-function, scientific, or graphing calculator, unless it has features described in the Prohibited Calculator's list (go to www.actstudent.org and enter "calculator" as a keyword search for the most up-to-date information on permitted and prohibited devices.) Calculators will be checked by supervisors in your assigned classroom on the day of the test. If you use a prohibited calculator, the student will be dismissed and your answer document will not be scored.

4. <u>Email address, Date of birth and Home address:</u> Home address must including street address, city, and zip code.

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

<u>Clock/Watch</u> A clock will be in every room to pace yourself. Your room supervisor will announce when 5 minutes remain on each test section as instructed by ACT. Watches cannot be worn but can be placed on the desk. NO watches with noise or internet. Noise must be turned to silence.

<u>Snacks/Water</u> to eat/drink outside the test room during the break must be placed under the desk during the testing periods. Snacks in a clear bag is highly suggested.

BACKPACKS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE TESTING CLASSROOM

LEAVE PACK BACKS/ELECTRONCIS IN LOCKERS!

→ DO NOT TAKE OR HANDLE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS INTO THE TEST ROOM OR USE DURING THE 15 MINUTE BREAK.

YOU WILL BE DISMISSED IF ANY OF THESE ITEMS ARE USED FROM 7:30 A.M. - END OF TESTING/DISMISSAL FROM TESTING ROOM AT APPROX. 12:30 PM

- 1. NO books, dictionaries, notes, scratch paper, or any unapproved testing aids
- 2. NO highlight pens, colored pens or pencils, or correction fluid
- 3. Examinees <u>may not handle or access</u> a cellphone or electronic device at any time in the test room or during breaks. This includes smart watches, fitness bands, and any other devices with recording, internet, or communications capabilities. All devices, including cell phones and wearable devices, must be turned off and placed out of sight. NO EAR PLUGS!
- 4. NO commercial hats/beanies/headbands/hoods on heads
- 5. NO reading material
- 6. NO BACK PACK
- 7. NO tobacco in any form.

BEFORE TEST DAY:

- 1. Prepare for the tests by reviewing "Preparing for the ACT", which can be downloaded from www.actstudent.org.
- 2. Complete the NON TEST at MyACT.org (included in envelope)
- 3. Have ready ID Photo document and #2 pencils with great erasers (no mechanical pencils)
- 4. Review the information about permitted and prohibited calculators. (handout in envelope)
- 5. CELLPHONE CALCULATORS CANNOT BE USED DURING THE MATH TEST!
- 6. Report for testing at 7:30 A.M. to your assigned room. You will not be admitted to test once the TEST booklets are being distributed.

Make up for ACT Test will be held on Tuesday, March 23, 2021, Cottonwood Heights City Hall auditorium. Starting at 8:30 a.m. Students will be put on an excuse list after TEST is taken.
