Upcoming Testing Information

Nov 4th - ASVAB Exam in the Twin Peaks

Is your student interested in joining the military? If so, they need to take the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery or the ASVAB (Az-Vab) test on Nov 4 in Twin Peaks right after school.

Nov 5th - Civics Exam in the Library during APP

All seniors that need to take the Civics Exam must report to the Library during APP on Nov 5th. The Civics Exam is mandatory for graduation. Seniors can check if they need to take it by logging into their Canvas account and will see the BHS Civics Course if they need to take the test.

Nov 8th – Deadline for AP Class Payments are due. Test are \$100 for full year tests. If a student does not pay for their test by the end of Nov 8th, a \$40 late fee will be added to their Skyward Account. If there are any questions about payment, please have them contact Erin Kaufman in Rm 1522.




