PTCs are this Thursday (Oct 2nd) from 3pm-8:30pm. The schedule will be as follows:

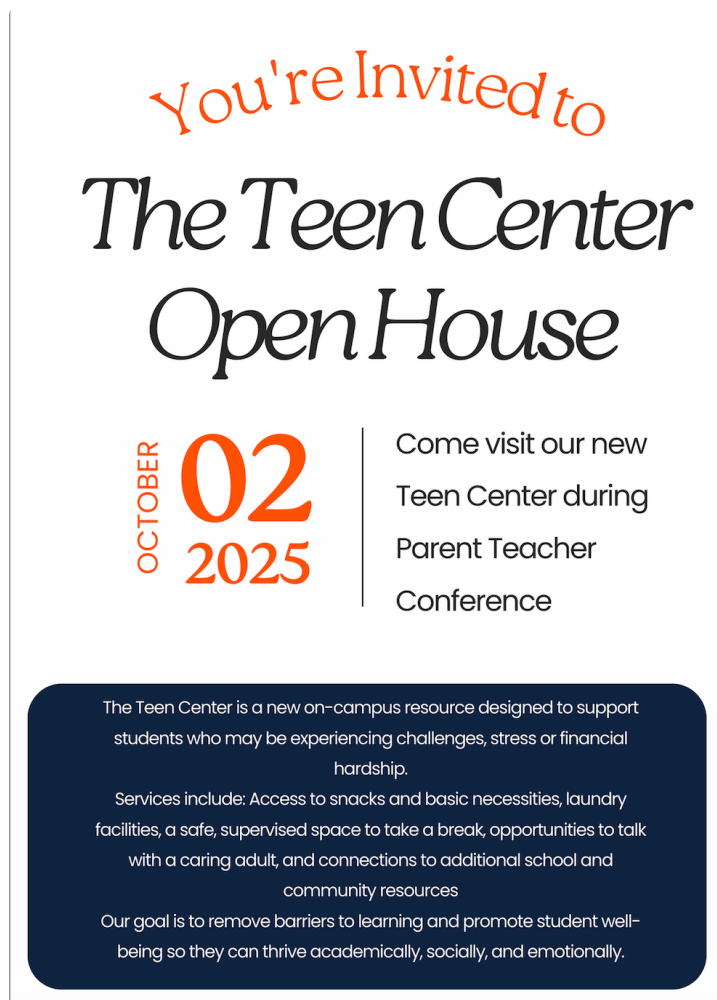
- 3-5:00pm scheduled virtual appointments

PSAT Test Option for 9th, 10th, 11th Graders

“The PSAT test is a practice test provided by the College Board to give students valuable feedback on their testing ability and knowledge to prepare them for their eventual taking of the ACT and SAT exams which are required for entrance into college and scholarship programs. The PSAT allows students to take a proctored exam in a secure testing environment and receive knowledge about their testing abilities and what they need to improve on for future testing. All 9th, 10th, and 11th graders are invited to take the PSAT exam. 11th graders who score well will be entered into the National Merit Finalist Scholarship competition and be eligible to receive \$300 million in available scholarships. The available testing date for Brighton High students is October 8th at 7 AM. There are two testing locations. The AUX Gym will be the main location. The Twin Peaks room will be reserved for overflow students once the AUX Gym has been filled. These locations will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. Payment must be received by September 30th in the Main Office. Students who need financial assistance should see Maria Bytendorp in the Main Office.”

APP Driver's ED for 2nd/3rd Trimester

Hello Parents/Guardians,

If your student is interested in taking Driver Education at Brighton this school year, please review the following information:

- **Regular Driver Ed Offerings:** The class is offered during 1st and 2nd periods throughout the year, as well as an online summer course.
- **Additional Option:** For students who cannot fit the class into their regular schedule, we are also offering Driver Ed during APP class in the 2nd and 3rd trimesters.

APP Driver Ed Schedule:

- **2nd Trimester:** November 17th, 2025 – February 26th, 2026 (57 days). Students must turn **16 before April 15th, 2026** to enroll.
- **3rd Trimester:** March 2nd, 2026 – May 29th, 2026 (57 days). This option is for students turning **16 after April 15, 2026**.
- Students who turn **16 after August 1, 2025** cannot take the APP class and will need to register for Driver Ed during the summer or next school year.

Important Details:

- Space is limited and spots will be given on a **first-come, first-served basis**.

- Students should have their **learner permit before the first day of class**.

BHS Attendance Policy Reminders

Here are some bullet-points of information about the new attendance policy:

- A degree mark will appear by a students grade in skyward when they have 7 or more tardies, way late tardies, verified trancies, or unexcused absences.
- A student is responsible for making up attendance with their classroom teacher. Make-up can be done during APP.
- Excusing any partial day/single period absences must be done that day. Call the attendance office by 3pm or send a message through ParentSquare by midnight.
- Tardies cannot be excused.
- Excusal of a full day absence must be done within 4 days of the absence.
