1st Trimester Honor Roll

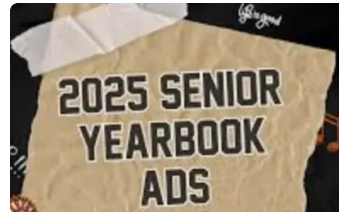
We are so proud of all our Brighton students and how their first trimester went. Below are the number of students per grade who made the Honor Roll for 1st trimester.
