Ryan Shupe Concert Fundraiser

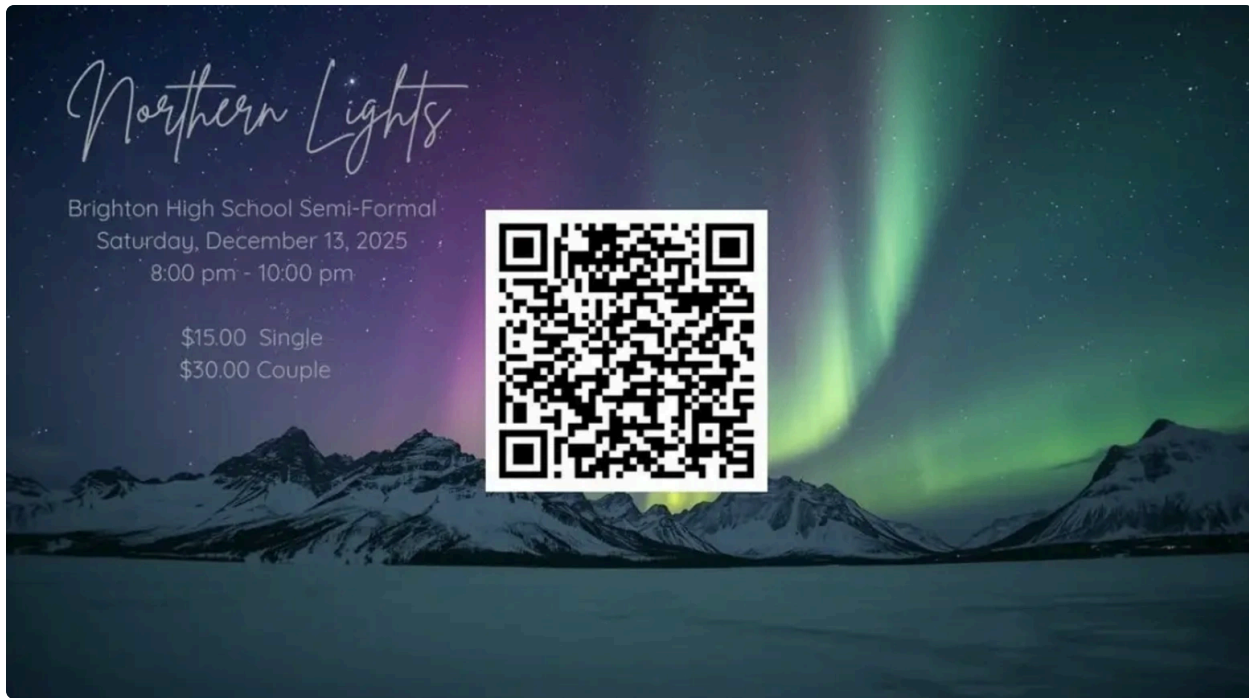

Brighton High Fundraiser Information

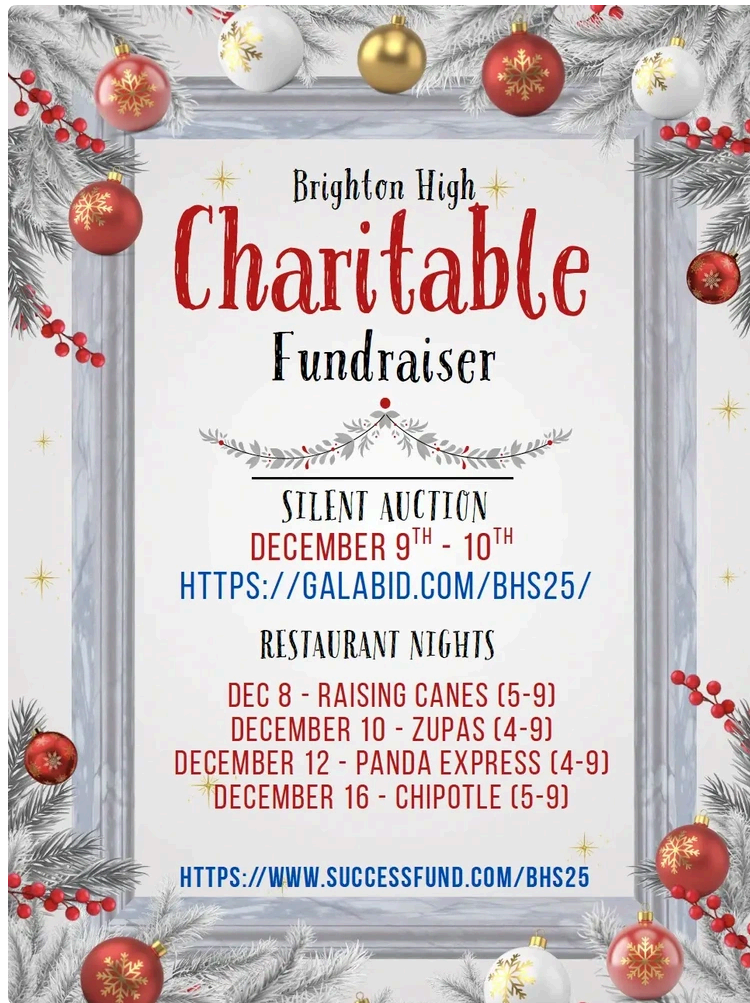
