Winter Sports Tryouts: This Week

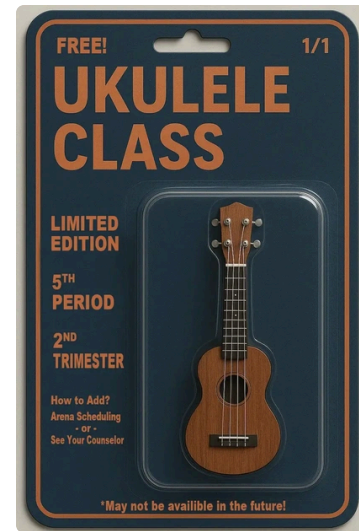
Are you interested in playing a winter sport?

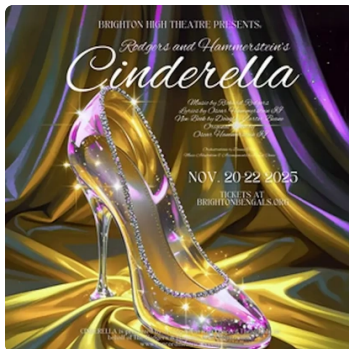
