Course Selection for the 26-27 School Year

Course selection for the **2026–2027 school year** will be open **February 9 through February 20**.

Students will attend a grade-level assembly where counselors will review the course selection process, provide time for students to enter their courses, and answer questions.

Assembly schedule:

- **Freshmen:** Monday February 9 during APP
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- **Sophomores:** Wednesday February 11 during APP
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- **Juniors:** Thursday February 12 at 7:45 a.m. (with College Day)

Students must log in to Skyward to enter their course requests for next school year. Students should select 15 total classes, which equals 7.5 credits (or 6.5 credits for students taking LDS Seminary).

Please remember that some classes are offered in multiple parts, so students should be sure to register for A, B, and/or C sections as needed.
