## 3rd Trimester Attendance Policy Review

As we start a new trimester its always a good idea to review our attendance policy. Please see the attached policy and/or the bullet points below.

Important Parent Bullet Points with the Attendance Policy:

- On the 7th student attendance mark in each class- a degree mark will appear by the student's grade (see attached policy for example image).
- Attendance marks that trigger this degree mark are: tardies, unexcused absences, truancies, and way lates
- When a student misses a full day of school, parents/guardians have up to 5 days to call/ PARENT Square /Skyward the attendance office to excuse.
- When a student misses a partial day, parents/guardians must call the attendance office before 3pm to excuse or Parent Square/Skyward same day.
- If a student is being checked-in or checked-out during the day, please call with prepared documentation (ie: doctor's note).
- **Tardies will not be excused.**
- Students can make-up attendance with their teachers during APP time.
- Please review teacher disclosures to best understand how they are using the attendance degree mark in their classes.




