Certificates and other Credentials

1 year or more
(depending on program)

Provides preparation for specific jobs and careers. Programs can typically be completed in a few weeks to a little over a year of full-time attendance. Many certificates build into and count toward associate degrees.

Examples:

- Certificates of Completion
- Apprenticeships
- Licenses
- Professional Certifications

Associate Degrees

2 years

Provides preparation for employment or a bachelor's degree. Programs can typically be completed in two years of full-time attendance.

Examples:*

- Associate of Applied Science
- Associate of Science
- Associate of Arts

4

Bachelor's Degrees

4 years

Provides a well-rounded education for success in a career or for graduate study. Programs can typically be completed in four years of full-time attendance.

Examples:

- Bachelor of Science
- Bachelor of Arts
- Bachelor of Applied Science
- Professional Bachelor's Degree

Graduate and Professional Degrees and Credentials

Typically 1-6 years
beyond a bachelor's degree

Provides advanced preparation in a variety of careers that require education beyond a bachelor's degree. Programs can typically be completed in one to six years of full-time attendance, depending on the field of study.

Examples:

- Master's degrees
- Doctoral degrees
- Graduate Certificates

Everyone needs some type of College after high school.

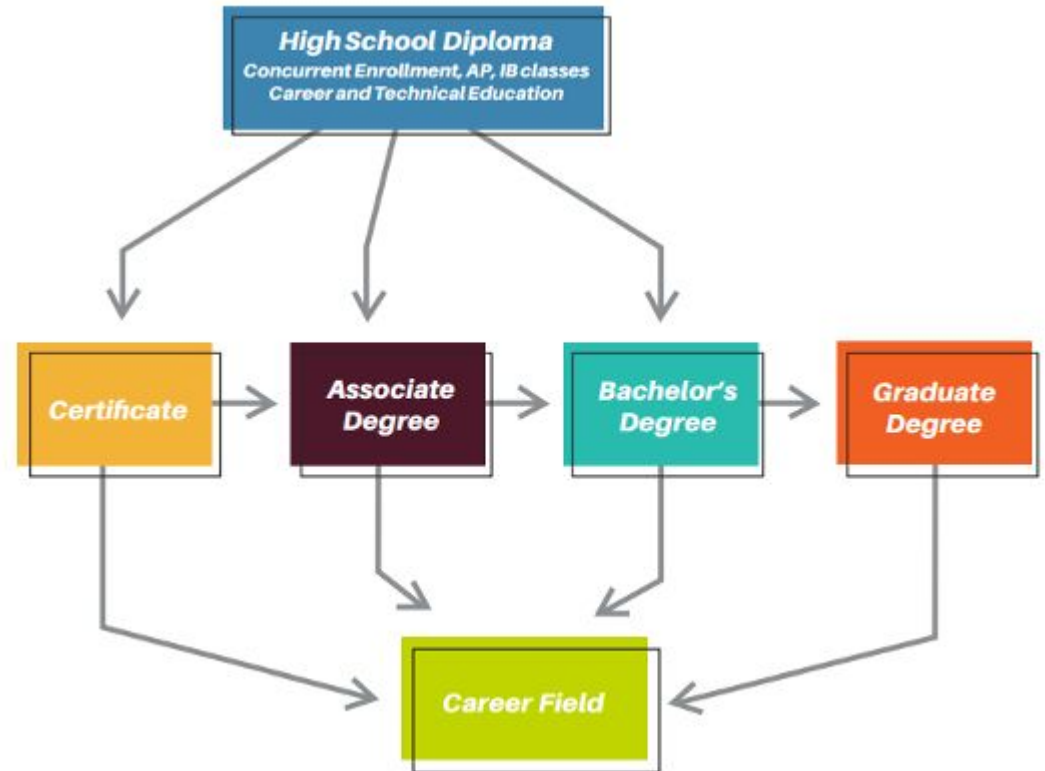
College refers to any education you receive for your current or future employment.

Review : Ways to Pay for College

- ❑ Get good grades - GPA matters
- ❑ Take and retake the ACT/SAT (practice tests)
- ❑ Apply for scholarships now
- ❑ Take college classes in high school - CE/AP
- ❑ Explore different courses to discover your interests
- ❑ Junior year consider a CTE Pathway - CTEC
- ❑ Apply for FAFSA (financial aid) senior year

What is a GPA and why does it matter?

- ❑ Grade Point Average - GPA
- ❑ When you apply to college your 9th 10th and 11th grades (GPA) will be on your transcript. Your grades now matter!
- ❑ You can get a scholarship for your grades. Good grades pay for college.
- ❑ Certain colleges require students to have good grades to be accepted.
- ❑ Grade replacement could improve your GPA.

What is the ACT and how can it help?

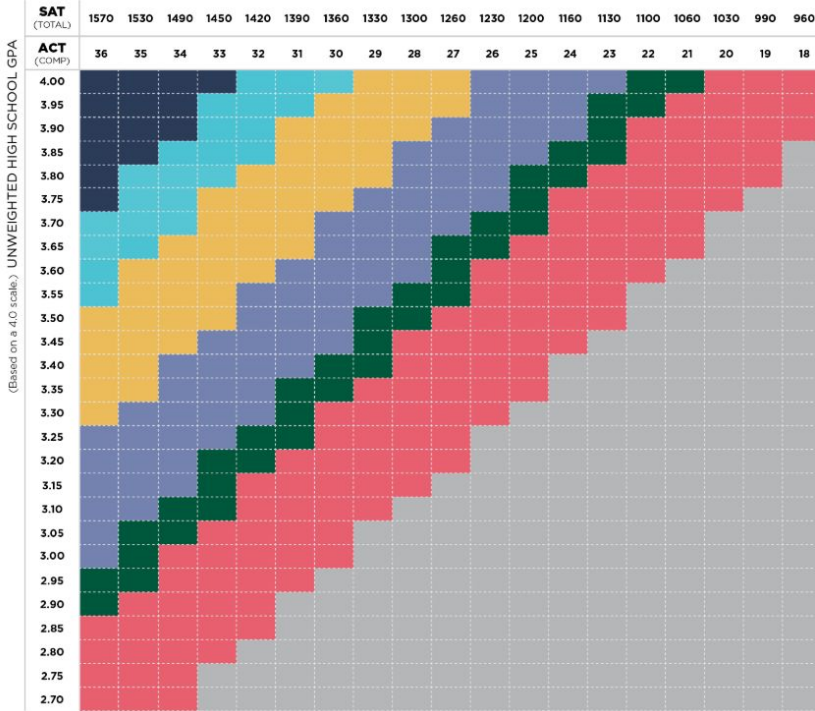
- ❑ The ACT is a college placement test that helps colleges gauge how much you've learned in school and predicts how well you might do in college.
- ❑ High ACT/SAT scores could qualify students for scholarships.
- ❑ At Brighton High School all 11th grade students have the opportunity to take the ACT for FREE
- ❑ Use an ACT test prep to help enhance your score.
