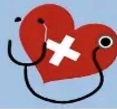
Hi-GEAR SUMMER CAMP

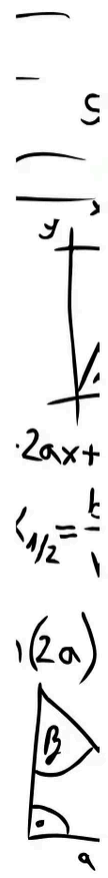

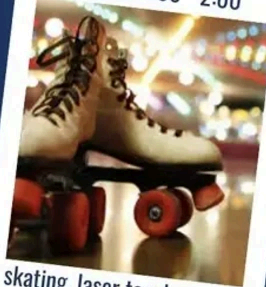
