



APP Period Disclosure 2026-27

Course Description:

The APP (Academic Preparation Period) provides a safe and consistent space for students to develop positive relationships, receive academic support, and have time to complete schoolwork during the school day.

- All students have an assigned teacher for APP (Academic Preparation Period).
- APP will be tied to 2nd period each Trimester. If you are on campus during 2nd period, you will be assigned an APP class.
- Students check in with a scanner to their designated class to receive academic support.

Students will productively use time during the school day to complete assignments or visit with content-specific teachers to receive remediation or educational enrichment and support.

- APP Class will be held Monday through Thursday.
- Students attend their assigned APP class on Monday for grade checks and weekly planning.
 - Weekly grade checks are a required assignment.
 - Grade checks are completed in class on Monday each week. Students who are absent that day can turn in their completed grade check by Friday of the same week.
 - Grade checks not turned in the same week they are due can be made up with a “grade check make-up assignment.” Please see the make-up assignment sheet on the APP Canvas Course.
 - **APP grade check make-up assignments must be completed within 2 weeks after the due date. Example – the grade check is due by Friday of the first week. If a make-up assignment is needed, it must be turned in by the 3rd Friday of the month to receive credit -- make-up grade checks are only accepted for the current trimester**
- On Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, students may attend any class **in their assigned schedule** for extra help where needed.
- Teachers may post that their room is full if they reach room capacity; students will then need to choose another class in their schedule to attend that day.

APP Classroom Rules & Expectations:

Respect

- Demonstrate respect, kindness, and tolerance for the teacher, other students and yourself.
- All students have the right to work without distractions.

Overcome

- Monitor your behavior so that you are not a distraction to other students and the learning environment.
- Come prepared to focus on your schoolwork.
- Use APP to catch up on missed work or receive additional instruction to enhance your learning.

Achieve

- Be an active member of your APP class.
- Come to APP on time every day, ready to work, fully engage in daily activities, and interact positively.

Reach - out

- Support and encourage peers to: build positive relationships, stay motivated and involved, use school programs to achieve academically, stay on track for graduation, and seek help and resources when needed.

Grading/Credit/Eligibility:

Grading is based on participation and regular attendance Monday-Thursday. Students earn a pass or fail grade each trimester. A passing grade will receive 0.16 elective credit per trimester or 0.50 elective credit per year.

APP grades are included in the trimester GPA and will impact eligibility with UHSAA sports/activities.

- Participation = 15 points per day (Monday - Thursday)
 - Excused absences receive NC (no count) for the day, which will not affect the grade. If students do not regularly attend APP, they will not receive a passing grade.
 - Students need to participate in APP activities. Students will participate in grade checks, weekly planning and engage in working with teachers to succeed in their courses.
- Grade check = 20 points per week
 - Each Monday, students will remain with their assigned APP teacher and are expected to complete a review of their current academic progress. Students will also use this time to make plans for additional academic supports for that week.
 - If a student misses a grade check as a result of an excused absence, students should turn in their grade check by Friday of the same week.
 - Grade checks not turned in the same week they are due can be made up with a “grade check make-up assignment.” Please see the make-up assignment sheet on the APP Canvas Course.
 - **APP grade check make-up assignments must be completed within 2 weeks after the due date. Example – the grade check is due by Friday of the first week. If a make-up assignment is needed, it must be turned in by the 3rd Friday of the month to receive credit -- make-up grade checks are only accepted for the current trimester**
- Returned/Signed Disclosure = 20 points
- Other school required items as needed (example: bringing in a chromebook for updates)
- **Students must earn an 80% from APP to earn credit.**

- *I understand that my APP grade includes participation points for attending and participating in class activities.*

- ***APP grade check make-up assignments must be completed within 2 weeks after the due date.** Example – the grade check is due by Friday of the first week. If a make-up assignment is needed, it must be turned in by the 3rd Friday of the month to receive credit -- make-up grade checks are only accepted for the current trimester*
- *Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, students attend APP with a teacher listed on their class schedule for that Trimester.*
