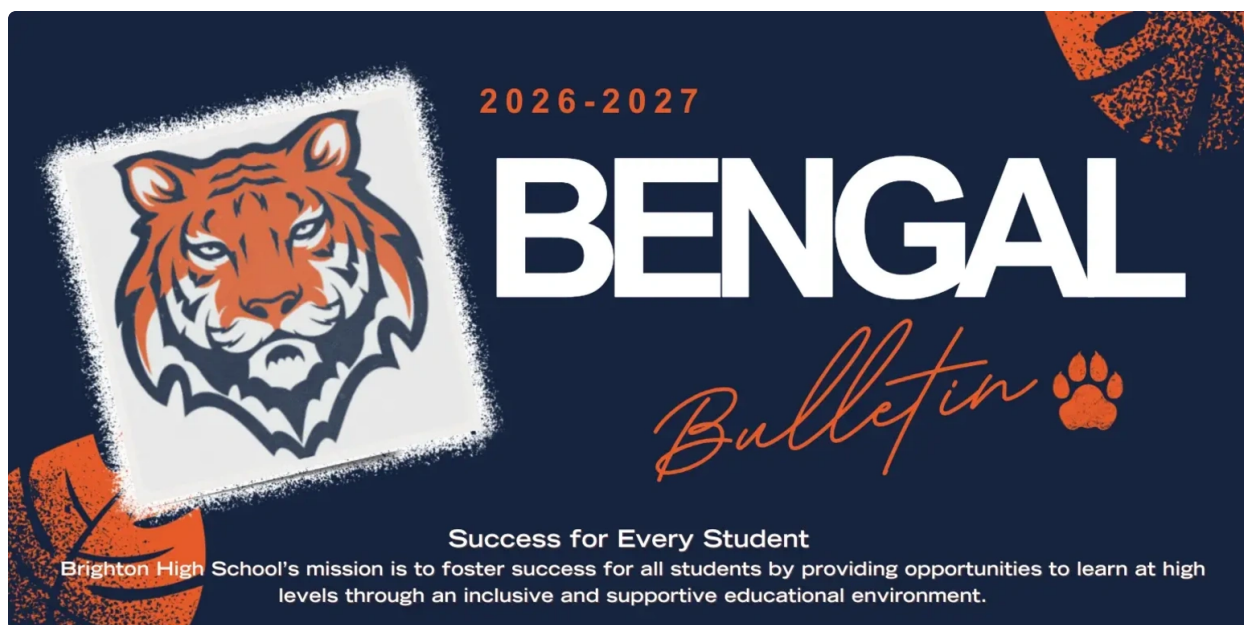

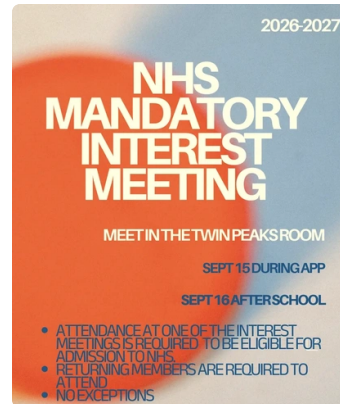
Brighton Personal Technology Policy

Chromebook Care Information

- If you have problems with your chromebook, please bring it to the library for an exchange during the first 5 school days. All district fines (see descriptions below) will be applied, starting on Friday, August 21, 2026.
- Your chromebook is assigned to you by the Canyons School District barcode – please do not remove this tag.
- The replacement cost of a chromebook is \$225.00.
- The replacement cost of and district fine for damage to the chromebook cord is \$30.00. Your cord is barcoded.
- A damaged keyboard will result in a \$50.00 district fine. This also includes a damaged trackpad or keyboard plate.
- A cracked, chipped, or damaged exterior hard shell will result in a \$50.00 district fine. This also includes a damaged audio jack, USB port, or charging port.
- Screen damage, including damaged pixels or a damaged LCD screen, will result in a \$50.00 district fine.
- All fines can be paid for on Skyward at the end of each trimester.
- If you return a chromebook that is not checked out to you, you are still responsible for the one that was originally checked out to you. Loaning or swapping chromebooks with friends could result in a fine.
- Please put your first and last name on the blank label on your chromebook.
- Whether you are using the Wi-Fi at home or at school, Canyons District has the ability to monitor your web activity.
- It is your responsibility to charge your chromebook every night and bring it to school every day.
- If you misplace your chromebook, go to the library to ask the staff to lock your device. Locking the device does not waive the replacement fine, but the device might be returned.

Brighton School Community Council Applications



Dear Brighton Community
Parents/Guardians,

We are now accepting applications to serve on this year's Brighton High School Community Council. Serving on a School Community Council (SCC) is a wonderful way for parents to be actively involved in their children's education. In Canyons School District, School Community Council members review school data, identify school needs, establish goals, and allocate funds toward accomplishing those objectives. Every year, each SCC creates school plans and reviews district plans with the overarching goal of addressing their greatest academic needs and creating an effective and safe learning environment for their school.

The Brighton High SCC can have up to 24 total SCC members (14 parents/10 staff members). The time commitment includes a meeting once a month with the exceptions of June and July. The meetings are usually held at 3:30pm on the 2nd Wednesday of the month. SCC members must commit to attend a minimum of 75% of the scheduled SCC meetings during the school year. Applications are due by August 25, 2026. If needed, elections will be held August 27th- September 2nd, 2026.

BHS Parking Permits

Parking permits for Juniors and Seniors will go on sale in the Main Office starting August 6th.

Permits will continue to be sold throughout the year, and a permit is available for any Junior/Senior with a valid driver's license and current car registration.

Permit Reminders:

- Read, print, and get signatures on the BHS Parking Rules/Regulations and Contract (see available links)
- The parking permit costs \$20
- When purchasing a permit, students must bring in:
 - A valid driver's license
 - The car's current registration
 - A signed BHS parking contract, including a guardian's signature
- A permit allows the student to park in the school's parking lots, but the permit does not guarantee a parking spot.
