Schedules will be available for viewing on Wednesday, August 5th. *Online Registration through Skyward must be completed **prior to** viewing your schedule in Skyward.*

Student schedules will be generated based on course requests that were submitted in the spring. **Arena Scheduling will open beginning August 5th and will be the ONLY online registration window to make class adjustments prior to the start of school.** Due to the district change over to an updated Skyward system, please be patient as we navigate this change.

Brighton High School Schedule Change Policy

Brighton High School is adopting a new schedule change policy for the 26 - 27 School year.

The New Policy	Why the Change?
Brighton will open Arena Scheduling one time during the academic school year. <i>This year, Arena will open from August 5 - 9.</i> During this window, students may make changes to any class for any reason. <i>Schedule Help Day will be offered on August 7 to support students who need help making schedule changes.</i> Once Arena Scheduling closes, no further schedule changes will be permitted for classes the first trimester. We understand that there are extenuating circumstances, and we encourage you to reach out to your Counselor as these arise. Students will still be able to come to the Counseling Center in order to - Add Educational Releases - Add Teacher, Counseling, or Office Aide - Complete a Level Change - Fill a hole in their schedule Prior to the start of 2nd and 3rd trimester, students may request schedule changes by submitting an online request through a designated Google Form. These requests will be reviewed and accommodated, subject to availability.	This updated process is centered on supporting student success in three key ways: 1. Protecting instructional time By eliminating schedule adjustments once the trimester begins, teachers can start teaching meaningful curriculum on the first day of class. This ensures students make the most of every instructional minute. 2. Encouraging thoughtful, full-year planning Opening Arena Scheduling once per year allows students to build their full academic schedule for the entire school year at one time, instead of making changes trimester by trimester. This approach helps prevent duplicate course enrollments, ensures students can register for both A and B halves of required graduation courses, and provides a clearer pathway for exploring college and career interests. 3. Strengthening school community A stable schedule allows students to build stronger relationships with teachers and peers. Expanding their experiences across a full year supports connection, consistency, and a stronger sense of belonging at Brighton.

New Student Enrollment

Pictures

- **All BHS students are required to obtain a school picture ID card** to be used to enter all activities and athletic events/venues, and to validate identification for specific testing and assessments (i.e., ACT). This picture will also be used for the student's yearbook photo.

- **Make-Up Pictures** will be taken on **Wednesday, September 2nd** for those students who bypass the original picture days of August 12 & 13. Students without an ID card will need to pay for activities and games until a school ID has been issued.
- **Picture Retakes** will be taken on **Tuesday, October 13th** for students who have taken original pictures, but would like a retake. Any student that has not taken pictures at this point can also have their picture taken this day so that they can receive an ID card.

Lockers

- Only those students requesting a locker will be issued a locker. If a student would like to rent a locker they will need to select that option during the online registration process. **It is strongly advised that no items of great value be brought to school.**

Parking Permits

Due to increased enrollment and limited parking capacity, we will continue to sell parking permits to **Seniors and Juniors ONLY**. Permits can be purchased in the Main Office at the cost of \$20 each beginning Monday, August 3rd. *Parking passes will be sold at any time during the school year to Seniors and Juniors with a valid driver's license and current car registration.*

Freshman Academy and PCCRs

Friday, August 14th, 8:30am Freshman Students and Parents/Guardians PCCR
Parents and Guardians – Plan to attend this meeting in the auditorium before Freshmen Academy. Counselors will be presenting important information about your student's High School Years. Counselors will also be meeting with 9th grade students individually throughout the year to create or update their 4-Year Plan.

Friday, August 14th, 9:00am – 11:30pm (Freshmen only)

Freshmen will attend planned orientation activities with teachers, counselors, administrators and student mentors to help them kick-off their Brighton High School experience. Incoming freshmen will have the opportunity to see their school, review school policies, rotate through their schedules, learn about lunch protocol and procedures, find out about upcoming dances and games, and discover how to become involved at BHS. Freshmen will also learn about “ROAR” and “APP,” two programs that reinforce academic achievement and promote positive school behaviors. Lunch will be provided.

Fee Waivers:

If you qualify or believe you may qualify for a Fee Wavier, you will need to meet with your assistant principal after August 3rd to complete that process in order to finalize your registration. Once your Fee Waiver has been approved, you will be able to view your schedule. Your assistant principal is assigned by the first letter of the student's last name.

School Lunch

Brighton High School operates a daily school breakfast and lunch program. The cost of a school breakfast for students will be \$1.25 and lunch will be \$2.25. We encourage all students to take advantage of the nutritious lunches that are prepared for them daily.

Student numbers are used as lunch numbers. Lunch deposits will be accepted at registration or in the cafeteria beginning the first day of school. ***We do not give IOU's or let students carry a debit balance at the high school level.***

We participate in the free or reduced lunch program and we encourage families to apply if they feel they are eligible. Forms may be found online at canyonsdistrict.org or in the Main Office.

Cell Phone Policy

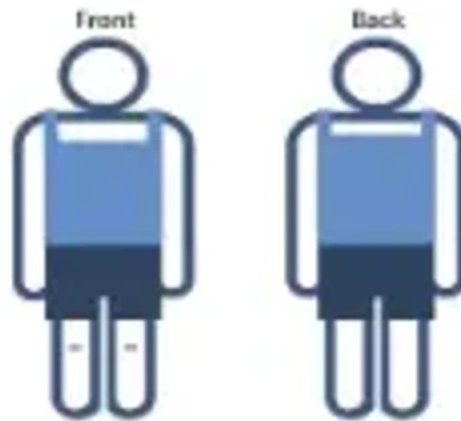
We strive to follow recent legislation as well as research regarding technology in the classrooms. Research shows there is a correlation between cell phone use in the classroom and inability to focus, habitual behaviors/lack of self-regulation, reduction of cognitive functioning/problem-solving, and compromised social interactions & communication skills (Himmelsbach, 2019; Morgan, n.d.; Tindell & Bohlander, 2012; The President and Fellows of Harvard College, 2019; Tossell et al., 2015; Whitford, 2018). In addition, “data indicates that the mere presence of one’s smartphone adversely affects... two measures of cognitive capacity - available working memory capacity, and functional fluid intelligence - even when participants were not using their phone (Ward, Duke, Gneezy, Bos, 2017) Minimizing distractions in the classroom (i.e. having a school-wide technology policy) would maximize learning.
