BHS Football Stadium Rules/Guidelines

We are excited for our first home football game this Friday!

To ensure a safe, fair, and enjoyable experience for all fans and student-athletes, please review the following Brighton High School stadium regulations before attending events:

- **Entry & Tickets:** Gates open at 6:00 PM. Please have physical or digital tickets ready to scan.
- **Middle School Policy:** Middle schoolers must be accompanied by their own paying parent; unsupervised drop-offs are prohibited.
- **Seating:** Seating is first-come, first-served. No reserving seats early—bleachers are cleared of reservation markers at 5:30 PM daily.
- **Prohibited Items:** Balls, frisbees, personal speakers, bikes, scooters, and rollerblades. All district property is tobacco, vape, and alcohol-free.
- **No Pit Parking:** reserved for visitor bus parking only.

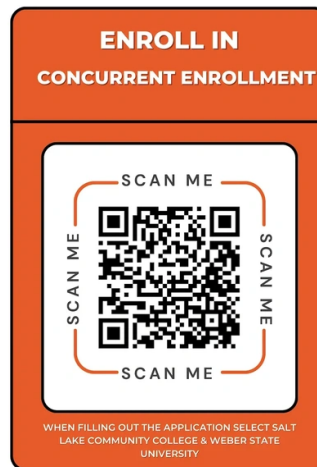

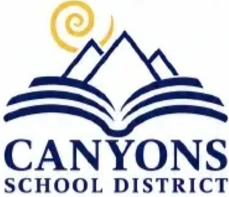
